POINTS TO CHECK	✓
1. BEFORE YOU START:	
a) What child/ren will you be working with and will they be able to understand a resource like this?	
b) What area/s do you need to focus on and is this resource type an appropriate strategy to use?	
c) What is the purpose and goal of your resource?	
d) Have you done background research to ensure you have an accurate understanding of the child's perspective and how they feel?	
2. PLANNING:	
a) What other strategies will you use alongside this resource?	
b) What ICT tools and Programs are you going to use?	
c) How will you approach introducing the topic and support the child/ren's understanding of it?	
d) How will you approach LOOK THINK DO?	
e) How are you going to approach the photos?	
f) How are you going to include possible changes in context?	
g) How are you going to involve the child/ren in planning, creating and/or editing the resource?	
h) How are you going to tailor the resource to the child's interests, abilities, and learning styles?	
3. CONTENT: TONE, TRUTHFULNESS, LANGUAGE AND STRUCTURE	
a) Is the resource positive and true to life?	
b) Is it clear and appropriate in terms of language and how it's laid out?	
4. EDITING, USING AND REVIEWING THE RESOURCE:	
a) When and how you are going to use and fade out the resource?	
b) When are you going to monitor and assess its effects?
